



Botox, Jeuveau, Xeomin, Dysport Consent Form

Facial lines or wrinkles are caused to a variable degree by muscle action. When a small amount of purified botulinum toxin is injected into a muscle, it causes weakness of that muscle, leading to improvement or disappearance of forehead lines, frown lines, bunny lines and crow's feet.

Lines present at rest may not improve.

Risks and Complications Specific to Botox Treatment

- Bruising
- Drooping of eyelids, or facial muscles
- Adjacent muscles can be affected
- Headache
- Double Vision
- Inadequate response to treatment
- Patients on aminoglycosides, penicillamine, quinine, and calcium channel blockers may experience stronger effects of botox

Results and Postoperative Care

- I will not be able to create these facial wrinkles while the injection is effective, but that the effect is reversible after a period of months, at which time retreatment is appropriate.
- I must not manipulate or rub the area of injection for a six hour period after the injection.
- It may take up to 7-10 days to attain the full effect from the Botox injections.
